Scope

This is the full version of our privacy policy, it will describe in full detail, how and why we collect personal information from you and the steps we take to protect it.

Collection of personal information

We collect information from you. Directly, when you provide us with your details (filling out forms, starting an account etc) and indirectly, when we obtain data regarding, how you got to our website and what you do while you are there. We use cookies on our website.

By using our website you agree to this Policy and you consent to our use of cookies in accordance with the terms of this Policy.

About Cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

There are two main kinds of cookies: "session" cookies and "persistent" cookies. Session cookies only last for the duration of users using the website and are deleted from your computer when you close your browser, whereas persistent cookies outlast user sessions and remain stored on your computer until deleted, or until they reach their expiry date.

Cookies help us provide you with a better website, by enabling us to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not.

Cookies do not contain any information that personally identifies you, a cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you.

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website.

Cookies on this Website

We use persistent cookies on this website to provide links to social network sharing services, and to update you on our most popular content.

Third Party Cookies

We do not use third party cookies.

Google Analytics

We also use cookies to help us improve the website's usability and for marketing purposes. We may also use cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about webpage traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to customer needs. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system.

For this purpose we use Google Analytics. Google Analytics generates statistical and other information about website use by means of cookies, which are stored on users' computers. The information generated relating to our website is used to create reports about the use of the website. Google will store and use this information. Google's privacy policy is available at www.google.com/privacypolicy.html.

We collect your information in both these ways to assist us in our growth as a company, and to further enhance your experience while dealing with us.

Our website uses a SSL (secure socket layer) certificate, which supports up to 256-bit encryption this creates a secure path between your computer and our website when you need to supply us with sensitive information like payment details, address, email, name and phone number.

You can check this is happening by looking for the letters HTTPS and the padlock symbol in the browser bar on your computer, usually located in the top left corner of your screen.

Our website is hosted on servers located in Sydney Australia.

Disclosure (Sharing)

When you make a purchase from us we use 3rd party companies to help our business and make your experience smoother. We use mail chimp to compile lists of our account holders and clients that sign up for our newsletter so we can keep you informed about

new products, changes to policies and any future developments.

For payments we use PayPal Australia. When you make a purchase from us we securely pass your information to PayPal, then you can make the choice to enter your credit card details or log into your PayPal account so that you can complete your payment.
